



Watering Solutions for Trees, Containers & Gardens

- Attach a hose to a spigot or faucet outside your home or building. No outdoor faucet? Try the ideas below
- Run a hose out the window from your kitchen or bathroom faucet, or from a garden-friendly neighbor's faucet
- Connect a hose from the sink in your building's basement and run it through an open window
- As a local deli if you can bring in a bucket and fill up in their sink to water nearby street trees
- Contact your local fire department or ask the parks department for permission and instructions to tap fire hydrants
- Ask people living on the first floor or in front of street trees to haul out a bucket or two of water for the trees once a week
- Use any solid barrel or bucket to catch rainwater, and empty into garden. Do not leave water standing too long during mosquito season.
